Dear Sir

I received your paper from J. N. Holmes - I repaired to James Fraser Saddler and was refused liberty ^{for} to touch the lead or Nematite vein - J. N. Holmes directed me in case Fraser should refuse for to go to Widow Campbell's land and search for it on her farm. She was not home I then went to John McDonald Weaver Specular ore. The work Dawson layed off for him to do was done and satisfactory I then marked a place for him to strip 300 yds North which he engaged for to do I then searched for the ore North and found no doubt

the out crop of the ore close to
the line between C McDonalds
and G Archibold I here marked
it for Charles McDonald to uncover
it early next week. Should this
last place prove for to be the
ore it will bring the ore or ex-
posure close to the mining area
or mile. I returned and called
for see Mrs Campbell. She was
still from home I found labor
scarce but will be more plenty
on Monday and on Monday I
will proceed as directed by
Holmes. Tomorrow I go to
Blanchard and to J. Frasers
river
