I was called on by James Holmes for to go on a survey to Websters. The plan shewn me and the survey made was the same. When we got to John W. Frasers Farm or Grant line as near as I could judge we were 80 rods or $\frac{1}{4}$ mile south of the Cr of the ore. The distance from Websters to the Grant line is one mile + 20 Rods or 340 rods in all - East of Websters there is considerable of ground included of land in the survey so that the whole of the area cannot be much over $\frac{5}{8}$ of a mile wide. Should I be laying off the same area for myself I would take the same plan except that I would take less land on the South side see sketch.
