

No. 2 is the seam <sup>cut</sup> through in fall Brook which shows the iron in the solid rock but it is in a very broken condition and therefore cannot be judged by the appearance it has in that place

No 3 is in McDonald's Brook but it makes but little show yet it can be easily distinguished from the stones seen on the surface

No. 4. is in Andrews Holmes's clearing and shows only in one place

No. 5. is on Sutherlands Farm and shows the solid rock on the surface about twelve feet in width and runs nearly North and South and has an Easterly dip

No 6 Shows on the road running between the french River and the post Road at Mr. Laurin's and shows only as a drift stone on the surface and as near as I could determine is running east and west and has a Northern dip the south side of the drift stone shows.

at Malcom Frasers clearing and on the road <sup>for</sup> nearly a mile in a North course from that place and it is likewise covered with <sup>the</sup> drift stone from the rock ~~and~~ at Sutherlands which lays south by forty degrees West from the place were the stone shows on the Road at frasers
