this Condition I think, applies equally  
well to the Cabinet, and I will make  
the suggestion when writing to Mr. Power.  
I will ask Mr. Weston to do what is  
necessary in respect to remounting and  
labelling the specimens - but I hardly  
think he can make a claim against  
Sir William for what he has done in
