Yours recent and kind
query in the subject I hasten
to reply. - The lot in question is
3 or 4th North Murray. - I am certain
a mistake has been made in
reference to Dr Wilson having got
the bogoon from lime masses as I
was with him many years ago when
he blasted out a large quantity
and it is as I described it a
distinct reef standing up about
10 or 12 inches above the general
surface. - I enclose a rough
sketch of the locality which
from the peculiar position has
I think never been visited by
any of the survey. - On the same
lot are fine crystals of Wilmite
and Chlorite. The latter sometimes
2 inches in diameter. - The
Bogoon is evidently connected

with the white crystalline limestone
of which an extensive ~~bed~~^{belt} runs
across these hills and overlaid
a couple of hundred yards to the
north by the sandstone I mentioned
before. - The large specimen I
sent you I broke off a piece
blasted out by Dr Wilson and
left because too heavy to lift.

If you wish additional specimens
I will be happy in that being to
supply you as I mean to remove
the earth and if possible find
the connection. - It cannot be
a loose mass as the reef is
distinctly traceable for a number
of feet from N.E. to S.W. and
with the exception of an apparently
narrow belt of Feldspar it is
or seems to be one bed of limestone
