I have read in the
Ann. & Mag. of Nat. Hist., ^{for this month} Messrs Rowney
and King's paper on "The Dawn of Life".
You were quite correct in stating in
your last paper that I had prepared
and examined hundreds of Eozoon
sections. Since the first slices were
made in 1865 I have certainly made
more than a thousand. It is not my
wish to enter into the Eozoon controversy
but rather to collect and prepare
specimens for those who are more
conversant with organic structure.
I must say however that in all the sections
I have made during the sixteen years I
have been connected with this In-
stitution I have never seen Eozoon
structure in any other rock than
