Dear Sir,

I append a rough sketch
of an interesting little lot
of Actinophylloids from Cossett's
Pit, with a couple of specimens
of ~~the~~ modern Actinophylloids
from the immediate vicinity -
the latter however are pteroyoids
and possibly well known to you.
I have collected a number of
specimens of Carboniferous
Limestone from W. side of Sydney
Haut. which in Strabon and
fossils remind me much of that

over my ab Catobow. If
agreements I will forward an
other box of fossils and specimens
which I find accumulating, in-
cluding the Limestone which may
lead to the identification of the
two.

I fully expect to take a trip
across the strata from head
of Gabarrs to Mira Loma and
hope to obtain some valuable
notes with regard to the struc-
ture and position of the strata
lying against the N. side of
the Metamorphic rocks.

Two recent visits to Cassatt's pit

have been reproductions of any
results, but I do not despair
of yet finding something worth
submitting to you.

It is believed by Mr. Hitchcock
that the LeCros seam is identical
with the Fitzpatrick seam
on Cowboy Road. If possible
I propose to make a collection
of fossils at the latter place
as a test.

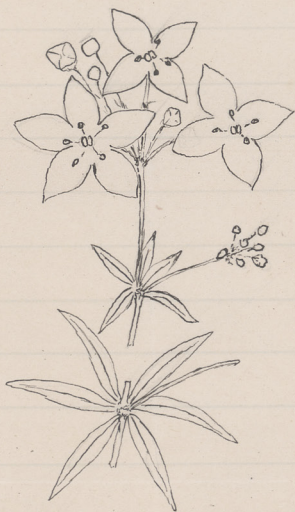
