Would you like to see some specimens of what I described as *Tuochophyllum* ~~lancea~~ *lancea* (see figs 24 & 25 and which seems to be identical with Hall's *Plumalina plumaria* and your *Syngedete Vanuxemi*. The structure is the same but my specimens may represent rather sporanges, as the stipes are quite full of macrospores. I may send you per mail enough to give you a good idea of the plant. But I think that Prof Andrews has already sent you some. The specimens come from the Waitey Sandstone of Ohio.
