Dear Sir

Your favor by P.C. was received a few days ago. The Bay is now completely blocked with ice so that no part of the shore or cliff is accessible, but I hope to be early on the ground in the Spring and to secure anything exposed or brought down by the frost. Quite a number of new stamps were showing themselves in the cliffs after the fall storms which may come down as the frost leaves.

There are indications of vigorous operations at these Mines the coming season and the construction of a Railway to connect with the

will place the Juggins within easy
reach and I trust lead to your
occasional prisoner here.

Should anything new be discovered
at the Reptile Reef I will not fail
to secure it immediately and ac-
