Dear Sir,

during the time I can spare from my usual official duties, I am preparing a Bibliography of North American Invertebrate Paleontology. You will greatly oblige me and expedite my work if you will inform me of the publications containing your published works of this kind. In the case of your publications in the Geological Magazine (London), the Canadian Naturalist &c, please give me the earliest date beyond which I need not search.

I have been appointed to the place upon the U.S. Geol. Survey of the Territories left vacant by the lamented Heek, and am desirous of making my work as effective as possible.

The Appropriation Committee of Congress have now the matter of the Survey appropriations before them and it will doubtless be decided within a week or 10 days, but we never feel sure of what we are to have until it is done. We hope however to go on as usual this year.
