named Executors to the last Will
and Testament - of the late Donald
Ross in his life time of the Parish of
Montreal in the District of Montreal
Esquire in and by virtue of a certain
Codicil made to the said last
Will and Testament, said Codicil
bearing date and executed before W
Ross and J. B. Houle' notaries at
Montreal aforesaid on the fifteenth
day of November one thousand
eight hundred and seventy six
said last Will and Testament
being executed before said W. Ross
and H. B. Wright - notaries on the
Nineteenth March one thousand
eight hundred and sixty Seven.

The said Romeo H. Stephens and
David J. Greenshield herein acting
merely provisionally for the pur-
-pose of having an Inventory taken
of the property and rights pertaining
to said Estate and Succession to ascer-
-tain the force thereof without in
any manner binding themselves

or either of them to accept or act as
such executors but on the contrary
resorting to themselves in the most
entire manner all and every right
to abstain from accepting or acting
as such executors and do formally
