My Dear Sir:

To day I have shipped to you a box of fossils containing about 130 species. They are from the Cincinnati Group Niagara Group & Lower Helderberg Group. I have sent you a considerable quantity of *Psilophyton gracillimum* of Lesquereux which I have been calling for the past five years *Graptolithus abnormis* and which I still think is a *Graptolite*.

I have labeled Cincinnati fossils corals & bryozoans *Chetetes* after Nicholson because you may more readily compare them with the Ohio survey but you will see by my work that I think *Chetetes* is a badly used up word — If you would like to have a copy of the Cin Quar Jour of Sci for the years 1874 & 1875 in exchange for the Canadian Naturalist or annual Reports of the Canadian Survey since 1866 I would like to make the exchange & will do so by mail.
