

For Sutherland's Medal

I return the drawings herewith. The work is correct and satisfactory with the following exceptions. The face in the wire model is rather too sunken and the head too short and the side of the lower lip is a little too heavy. Please compare these points with the photograph and moderate them a little.

With regard to the cast - that in the dies is satisfactory, provided they are carefully made. The circular cut in gold copies across long and if it can be diminished by reducing a very little the diameter of the medal, this will be desirable.

The work should be proceeded with as speedily as possible and if you can do so it will be well to send an improved model or tracing of the head before finally completing it.
