My dear Sir,

You will doubtless remember that at last meeting of our Committee two Communications were read from the Corresponding Committee of the Colonial Church and School Society, Montreal, and the following Resolution in regard to them was passed: —

“That the letter of the Rev. Dean Bond and others in reference to the claim of the Colonial & Church Society School, Montreal, to a grant

from the Superior Education Fund, be referred to The Hon. Judge Day, The Hon. M^r Ferrier, and D^r Dawson to confer with the parties interested and report.

I enclose the Documents referred to, that you may have them for reference in your negotiations with the parties concerned. It may perhaps be as well to keep them to be filed past with my papers.

I have just seen the Superintendent of Public Instruction in regard your motion put & passed at our last meeting: viz
"That the Superintendent be requested to furnish Professor Weir & M^r Emberson

with forms of returns similar to those employed in a former examination by M^r Emberson, and he tells me he has no such returns to give us.

I do not think that he will print them at the expense of the Department, and in these circumstances I would suggest that M^r Emberson be authorized to have them printed by Lozell. May I request you to have the kindness to see M^r Emberson, or communicate with him in regard to this matter. The expense cannot be very great, even if it has to be taken from the Committee's Contingent Fund. The matter will have to be attended to at once as there is no time now to lose.
