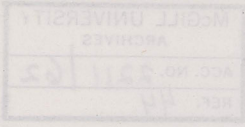

In answer

I beg to say that
I have telegraphed this
morning to say that
I can meet Mr Patterson
& Capt Bryant any time
this week at Atle's
Hotel, Little Metis, (the
station is St Omer
summit) It would

be a little service to
meet them merely
at the station, as
the train stops only
for a few seconds;
but if telegraphed to,
I can send a carriage
to the station to meet
them ^{& bring things to the hotel,} The train arrives
at St Octave about 5 PM
and it would be necessary
to stay over here, and
go on with the train
next morning. There



is however a good
hotel here, and I need
undertake to drive there
from and to the station
(about 5 miles).

As requested I send
memo of my charge
for Survey and Report.
I have reduced the amt
from that which I
mentioned in the
first instance, as I was
relieved from nearly all
expense on the ground

of the kindness of Messrs
Miller & Henshaw. I
shall of course be pre-
pared to give any
additional information
