have been mislaid owing to my

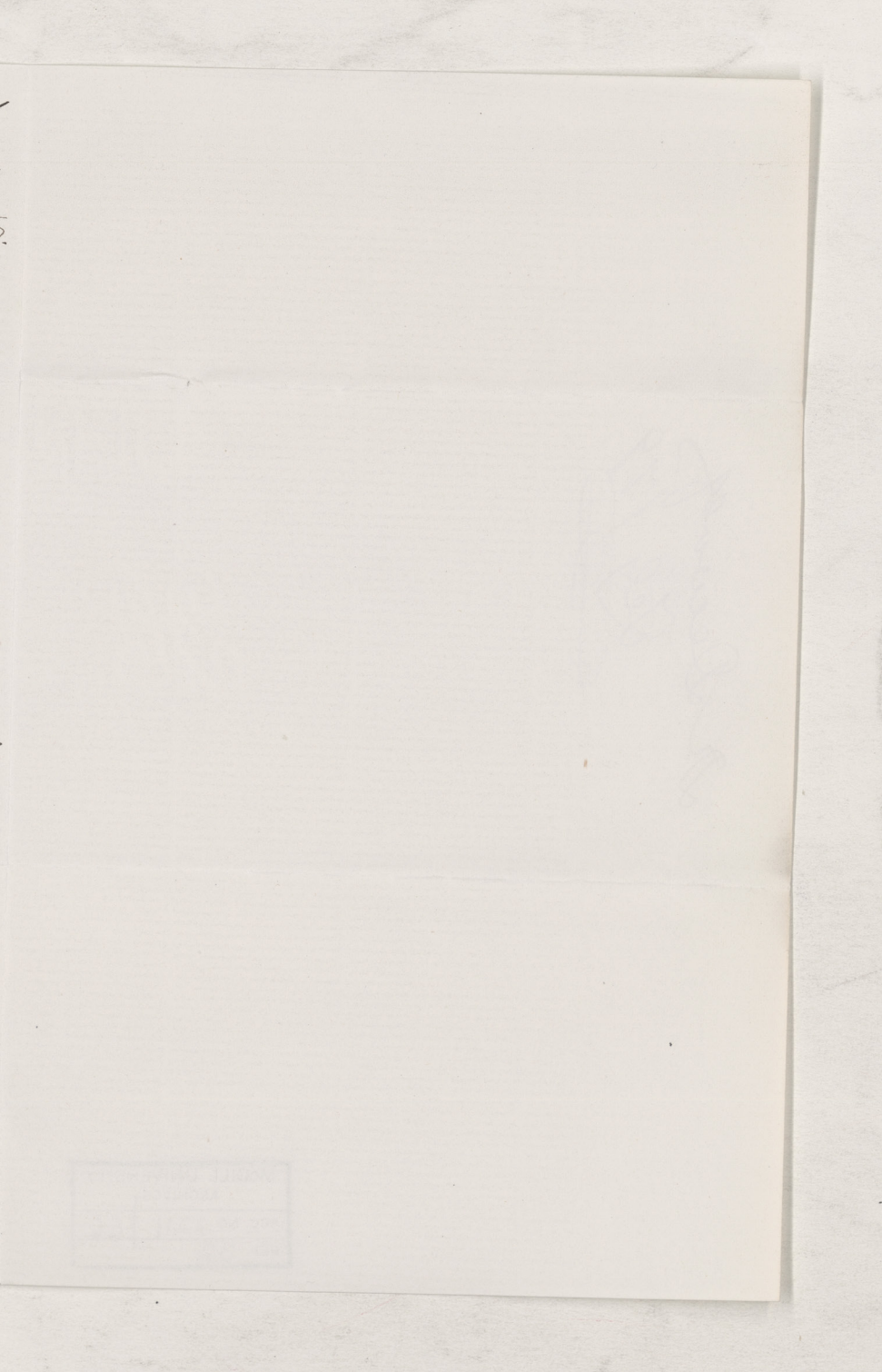
removal. I left Halifax in April
