

At a conference of representatives of the Faculties and Students of the College and Seminary held in Princeton January 13th 1880 it was

Resolution Resolved "That we approve of the continuance of the Collegiate Department of the Y. M. C. A. and also of an effort to make systematic provision for the expenses of the department."

Committee A committee, consisting of Professors W. Henry Green, J. T. Duffield, J. O. Murray, Rev. Wm Harris and Mr W. M. Jacobus, was appointed to devise a scheme for carrying into effect the latter part of this resolution.

Recommendations The committee recommend that a circular be prepared by the College Secretary, Mr L. D. Wishard giving information in regard to the origin, objects and methods of the work in Colleges and that the same be sent to Pastors of churches and individuals likely to be interested, accompanied by the following letter of approval to be signed by the Presidents of Colleges Professors in Theological Seminaries and by pastors who have been made acquainted with the facts,
