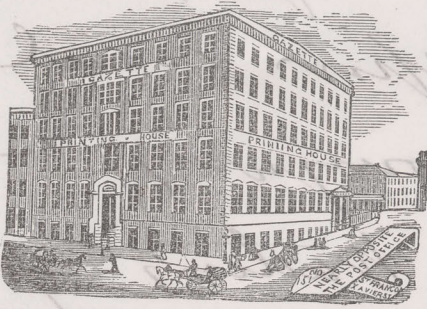

THE EDUCATIONAL RECORD

OF THE PROVINCE OF QUEBEC.

It is proposed to issue a monthly periodical of 48 pages, demy 8vo, in the same type and of the same general appearance as "THE BYSTANDER."

The title adopted is *THE EDUCATIONAL RECORD*, and it will be the organ of communication between the Department of Education and the Teachers of the Province. All such minutes or orders as the Council wish to publish will be contained therein, so that the "RECORD" will become the official organ of the Council.

Communications from teachers, and papers bearing upon school work, or upon educational matters generally, will be published, and abstracts will be given of the proceedings at educational meetings.

Selections will be made from foreign journals of articles having an interest in this Province, and news from all quarters on educational matters will have a place on the pages of the "RECORD." Space will also be devoted every month to an abstract of literary and scientific news.
