Sir

I return the specimen from Rocky Bay, for which I am much obliged. It seems to be from the conglomerate that underlies the greater part of Madame Island. If you know the exact place it was taken from, I could say more, because we surveyed all the shore of Rocky Bay. I send you a plan showing the principal roads, streams, etc. of Madame Island. It does not, however, represent nearly all the traverses made there; still we do not seem to have enough.

The structure of the mainland to the northwestward is complicated and exposures are far apart. If you have a copy of your report and map on the Richmond coalfield and of Barnes' report on Seacoal Bay, I should be glad to see them. There were perhaps outcrops and openings on coal-seams, etc. seen by you, which are not now accessible, as no mining has been done in the district for many years.
