My dear Sir,

With reference

to our conversation on
Wednesday last while
I regret that you could
hold out no expectation
of a change of the
"St Octave" station to the
Carping at Duchesne's,
which I believe would
be in the interest not
only of the inhabitants

and butlers at Little
Metes & Eastward but
of the railway itself,
I believe it would
be beneficial even
to change the name
of the "So Octave" station
to Little Metes Station
or Polit Metes Station,
and that of the
way station now
called "Metes" station to

Grand Metis Station.

The names proposed
would enable travellers
more easily to know
the stations at which
to stop for these
places respectively.

If this change of
names can be made
I have no doubt
it would be agreeable
to all interested.

I trust it may be
a preparation in so far
of such change in the
Station arrangements as
may be more convenient
than the present.
