

Monday 27<sup>th</sup> June (1889)

My dear Dr Dawson

Lynch handed me  
the amendment you wanted to Bill 45  
but it was strongly opposed by every  
Lawyer in both Houses <sup>so</sup> that the Attorney  
General and Lynch himself requested me  
to withdraw the amendment, —

Your telegraph from Sherbrooke  
I showed to Lynch before I left on Saturday  
~~he said~~, he said the Bill should not  
pass this session, from the opposition  
by the City Council of Montreal to the  
extra Tax on property for Schools — I leave  
again at 3 o'clock on 7 by Boat
