availed themselves of the offer
of the Art Association, & it will
prevent an indiscriminate use
of the tickets by people who
merely travel for the sake of
the

notoriety of being present at
Montreal during the Association's
visit or take the opportunity
of travelling at a reduced fare.

The Council do not, and I
am sure I do not wish to give
the tickets to every hanger on
of the meeting. Of course the
members of the Press may be
privileged
