Minneapolis, Minn., 12 July 1883.

Dr. J. W. Dawson:

I am mortified that I have not been able ^{to} this moment to write any thing definite in reply to yours asking about reduced rates from Winnipeg - I have had to depend on the motions of sub-committees, & they have been slow to act. - However, I have procured a pass for you from St. Vincent to Minneapolis, on the St. Paul, Minneapolis and Manitoba railroad, but have no information from the Canada Pacific, from Winnipeg to St. Vincent. In general the St. P. M. & M. R.R. gives return - rates - free to all members, also the Northern Pacific. We have not yet definite information about all our excursions, and our Local Circular will be printed tomorrow, without it, but later we will give more information by special circular. With that reception our Local Circular is completed.

I hope this information about travel between Winnipeg & Minneapolis will not be too late to be of use
