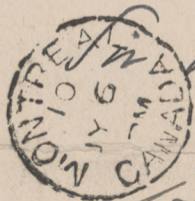

 ample from Mayon Creek &  
 which I call Graecophonus car-  
bonarius. I have made another  
 drawing of your fossil, and  
 redescribed it, & will send  
 it to you by express together  
 with the woodcut sent  
 Science, as soon as the  
 latter comes to hand. I have  
 done some thing on the Siberian Scor-  
 pions Myni apods, but they ~~are~~ are so  
 fragmentary I have been waiting for  
 something to turn up in other carboni-  
 ferous deposits to help me out with them.  
 The scorpion particularly is very frag-  
 mentary as are all other American
