Dear Sir,

The little shell from Anticosti enclosed in your letter of yesterday seems to me to come very near to Billings' Cyclonema humilis, from the Anticosti Group of "The Jumpers", Anticosti. Our specimens of C. humilis are ~~not~~ a little worn though they have the whole of the test preserved. In your specimen, which I enclose herein, however, I do not see any traces of the spiral lines mentioned by Billings, and moreover, in my judgement, your shell is a Holopea. It would require a series of specimens to enable me to form an opinion as to the true ^{specific} affinities of this little shell.
