My Dear Sir Willson,

I have not been
unmindful of your courtesies
and your gifts of books, although
I have not written you for
a long time - We have not
done much in the line
of Geology and Fossils since
you were here - Mr. West
has been transferred to the
Chair of Mathematics and
Astronomy - and W. Glover - a
young man - has taken his
place - I have enjoyed
reading your "Essays & Papers"
Much. Mrs Bliss and
myself visited Jerusalem
in July and August, &c.

Morning there there or
four weeks - We were fully
convinced that the "Skull
Hill" has more arguments
in favor of its being the
place of the crucifixion
