Dear Mr Hodder,

I return proof of map
and also original with this,
and a short paragraph relating to
the map to add to the preface.

The map is very good
and the colours excellent. I
have however had to make several
corrections in names and a few
in the lines of geol. formations
which I hope can be easily done.

The principal errors are
one in the coast in Northern Palestine
and another in the Upper Nile.
The first is an error of your artist
who has stretched out the coast
North of Caesarea so as to place
Beirut too far north. The second
is my own mistake or that
of my draughtsman, in putting

Spouse considerably too far
South. I hope these can be
collected, as they would much
impair the value of the maps

I fear the map may
prove to be too large for the
page. If so, it can be
reduced between the pencil
lines I have drawn; but I
would not have this done
unless absolutely necessary.

I have written full directions
to the artist and attached them
to the map.
