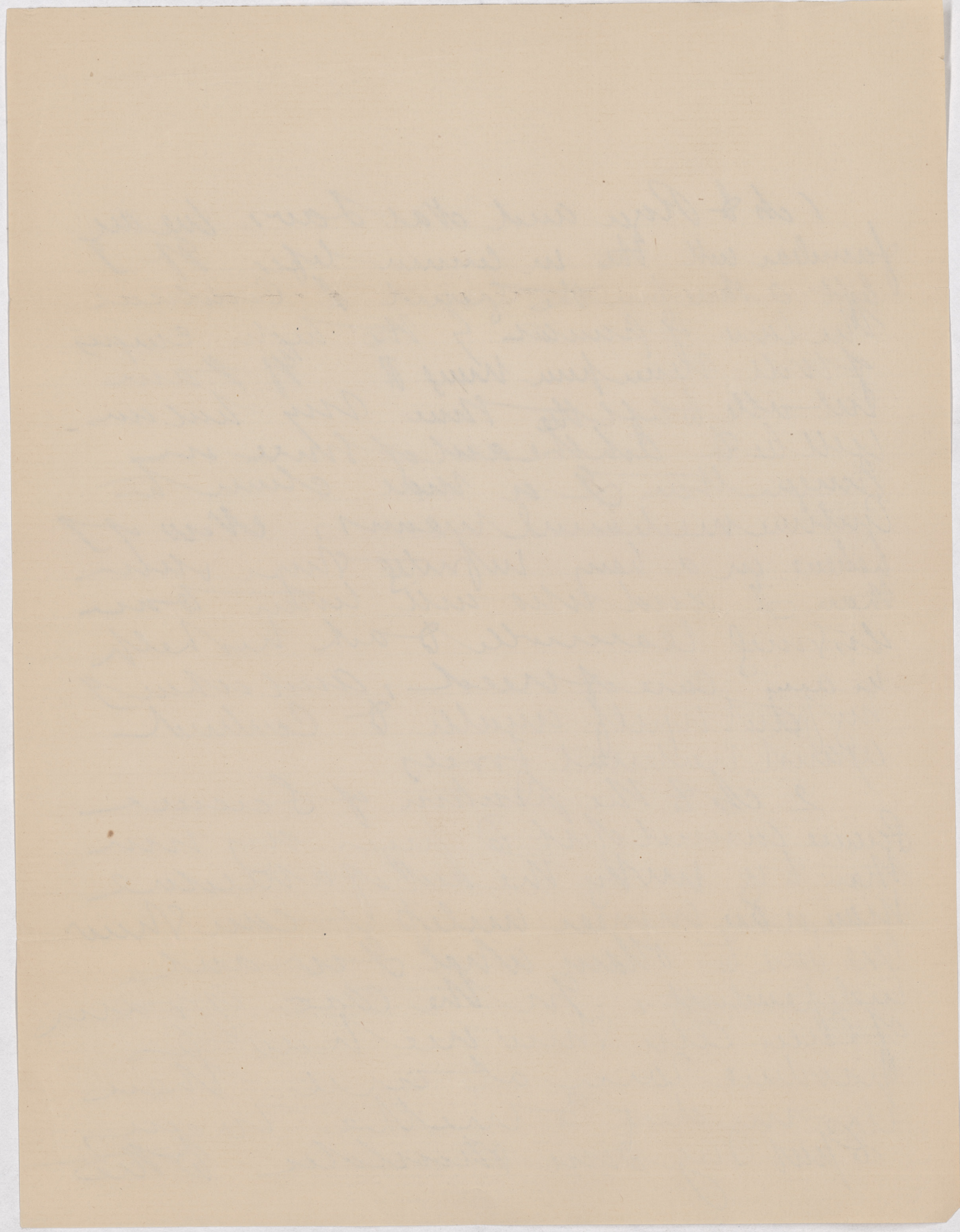

You may remember an application
submitted with respect to the application
of the King's license to name "an apprenticeship
day" as the act has it on other laws

referred to the Surgeon General with
a copy of the Quebec Medical Act & they
