For some time past I have been under the impression that we ought to print under the form of a circular for public and free distribution some of the articles of our paper L'Aurore & specially those which are of actual interest. This might be done in a cheap way because the matter being set for the paper could be used for that purpose.

In my estimation it would be a powerful help to our missionary work among the French.

Take for example the article in last week no in answer to "Le Chat" or the one before by Prof Courssiat, they would be read by a great many in this way and no doubt start them to thinking.

This would be for our work much more useful than tracts & other publications. All we need is the money for doing it. I am unable to spare the money for it and besides in editing the paper I do it for such a small pay that I can not afford doing more. If you think the plan a good one will you be kind enough to push it forward. I spoke to Prof Courssiat

about it and he approves of it as also Mr Cruchel, but
no one has moved in the matter. I take the liberty
of writing to you on this matter because, in the past
you have helped about my school books when we
were favored the plan among our publishers & yet
we were right in doing it.

I am sure that it would provoke a great
opposition in the Church of Rome & excite people
but what of it; we will hide the truth.
