I am much pleased to learn that you have succeeded in finding the terminations of two leaves of the plant under examination. The leaves of *Cordaites borassifolius* and *C. lingulatus* are often irregularly truncated in appearance, the end having prematurely withered and wasted, often split sometimes curled or rolled. You probably have seen the same thing, if not I will try to find portable examples to send you if desired. The specimens may however be sufficiently distinct to tell whether the termination is the natural one or not.
