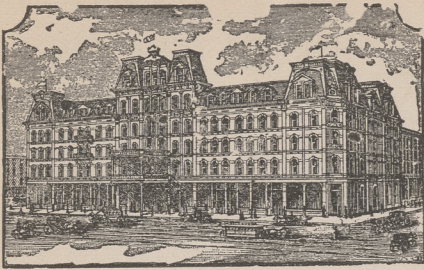

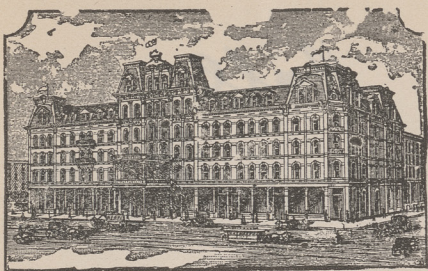
Ottawa, April 9<sup>th</sup> 1890

My dear Mr. Williams

I take the first moment after my arrival to write you, apologizing for not having explained to Lady Dawson my misfortune or my carelessness, in having broken the Globe over the gaslight. Notwithstanding my experience last night, almost the first thing I did, after rising this morning was to run my head against the gas-burner and throw down the Globe.
