

Some drawings of the manuscript  
of the "Bible-Minded Readers" by  
John Wycliffe, which was written  
in Latin and English, and which  
is now in the British Museum.  
The manuscript is very large  
and contains many illustrations  
and marginalia. The author,  
John Wycliffe, was a prominent  
English theologian and  
was one of the leaders of  
the Lollard movement. He  
wrote several books on  
theology and philosophy,  
and also on politics and  
economics. His works  
are now in the British  
Library, and are available  
for study and research.
