May I ask your opinion as to the possibility of workable seams of coal being found to the west of the seam known in the Sydney District as the Mullins seam. It is recognized in Fletcher & Robb's Report as the Westernmost seam in the District - is on the S. side of Spanish River & is about 7 ft thick. Seams 6 to 8 feet in thickness are now said to have been found by borings in the neighborhood of Mica near Black Brook at the depth of between 135 and 270 ft. Strong suspicions are en-
