The following resolution was unanimously adopted at the last meeting of the Protestant Board of School Commissioners, of Montreal. All persons interested are requested to govern themselves accordingly.—

"It having been represented to the Board that children of parents residing beyond the City Limits have been received into the Commissioners' Schools, to the exclusion of children of tax paying parents,—

"BE IT RESOLVED,

That after the first of JANUARY next, no child of non-resident and non-tax paying parents shall be admitted to, or retained in, the Protestant Public Schools of this City, until provision shall have been made for all applicants resident in the City.

"Should room be found in any school for the children of non-residents, they will be admitted from month to month, so long as there are no applications unprovided for from within the City, on payment of \$1 per month, in advance."
