~~The following resolution was unanimously adopted at
the last meeting of the Protestant Board of School Com-
missioners, of Montreal. All persons interested are re-
quested to govern themselves accordingly.—~~

“ It having been represented to the Board that children
of parents residing beyond the City Limits have been
received into the Commissioners' Schools, to the exclusion
of children of ~~tax paying~~ parents, — *residents*

“ BE IT RESOLVED,

That ~~after the first of JANUARY next~~, no child of non-resi-
dent ~~and non tax paying~~ parents shall be admitted to, or
retained in, the Protestant Public Schools of this City,
until provision shall have been made for all applicants
resident in the City.

“ Should room be found in any school for the children
of non-residents, they will be admitted from month to
month, so long as there are no applications unprovided
for from within the City, on payment of \$1 per month, in
advance.”
