Milk River

Dear Father,

We are camped this morning on the Milk River, where the trail from Benton to Macleod crosses it. From here I go westward to the St Mary's along the Milk, & then strike east to Macleod again, reaching it perhaps in about ten days. Our trip is for business purposes, with good weather. At Macleod I hope to find some more mail, as we will have been gone nearly a month of the time we get back. Mr. Conwell leaves this morning on a brand expedition on the buckboard to Chin Coulee. Breakfast is just ready, & I have everything packed up. With love to all your affectionate son
