I send you post
today the only plant found
by Mr McConnell last
Summer. It is evidently a
Cycad member, those from Paris
R. region. However certainly
Cretaceous. Pure, possibly
lower. Will be able to tell
better when work is plotted.
It was not quite close to the
base of the old rocks of the mt.

The age of the Mill Creek
 beds may I think now be
 put down as probably
 Tertiary. I have not yet
 had time to look up the
 Silicified woods from the
 Sus-Qua R region, but
 will do so soon.

The clothes which Mother was
 kind to the cleaners have
 arrived safely
