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Saturday 21 March 1885-

My dear Father,

I today borrowed & forwarded to you by mail, Hull's book which you wished to consult. It is the personal property of Dr Selwyn, & though he is not using it at present, you might return it to me by mail when you have done with it.

In looking further into the matter I find a subsequent partial recantation of the idea of the Arctic dry-land in S. Silurian time (De Rance Q. J. G.S. Vol 34 ps. 55-7.)
