Spence's Bridge, R.C.
11 July. 1888

My dear Father,

I reached this place
this morning, having spent the
past ten days in the Country between
Kamloops & here. I have sent packs
on down Thompson R to Mission
& will follow them to Camp there
this evening. Mail is at Kamloops
& I have telegraphed to have it sent
down by tonight's train to here & made
arrangements for an Indian to bring
it on to Camp. I write now merely
to report myself, not having anything
to reply to in the way of Correspondence.
Weather is extremely warm during middle
of day but am quite well & work
progressing as well as can be
expected. On getting here I found that
William had passed up the line

toward Kamloops yesterday,
on a hand Car so that I
narrowly missed meeting him.
