I see your general conclusions
on fossil plants in last number of American
Geological & take the following corrections.
On p 95-5 1700 feet should read 700 feet
Same again in foot-note to next page.
700 feet is the approx. thickness of marl
Pierre & Fort Hill. It is true that the plants
on west of them were not same way down in
the Belly River, but at west not ^{or 500} 400 feet
below base of Pierre. So that if the statement is
changed to 700 feet of marl beds it will
do.
