age of neither is well known, but

The first may be Cambrian  
while the second may be  
Cambrian. It cannot be  
Archaean.

One is limestone & the other  
- the one a contact deposit between  
limestone & granite. The other  
appears to be limestone &  
dolomite.

I am to dine on Saturday at

all to get down for Sunday, but  
can hardly spend two or three  
days in Montreal next week  
during the Easter holidays.
