Dear Anne,

I have just-
received your letter & will
forward Mamma's & Papa's to them
tomorrow morning.

I was prevented from writing
to you last Sunday & all my
spare ~~now~~ time now is
devoted to going over back work
for the exams which take place
week after next. I am

getting more & more discouraged
about them, & it is now so
late that it is impossible to
work up to any extent, as you either
get horribly stupid, or go to sleep

over your books. I will try to add a few words tomorrow
morning.

We have had no rain here
for ever so long & the
flocks are all brown & dry
like small tobacco plants.

It seems hardly worth
while sending this scrap
but I suppose I had better
do so just that a mail
may not be missed.

I hope to send you a little
longer letter next time
