My Dear Anna

After writing Mamma's letter I feel almost persuaded that I did not write to you last week. I thinking that I would be quite too bad to miss you for two mails in succession, especially when you have written so frequently & such long letters to me; am just going to write you this little note as a remembrance.

I wrote to Mrs Reed before Christmas saying that I could not go to spend Christmas holidays there this winter. Yesterday I got a letter from her which she had written in January & which had been traveling about

ever since. The only mistake in the address was that Hasley was written instead of Halsey. I suppose however that this caused the P.O. officials to look in the wrong part of the directory, & so finding no Hasley street, sent it to Harley St; & almost every other street of the same name in London, except the right one.

It then went to the dead letter office, was returned to Rochdale, sent ^{post} on there by Mrs Reed to Dalkitt, & finally forwarded to my correct address, & arrived all covered with postmarks & mysterious post-office signs. As I promised to read a little piece of the Bible every evening, of course I still continue to do so, though sometimes when I am tired it is rather a bother.
