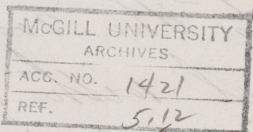
Letter to Bernard for

St Andrews July 4<sup>th</sup> 1871



My dear Bernard.

Papa wants me to tell you that your money will be forthcoming in time. I suppose you cannot leave till after Commencement, which I see in the N.Y. Observer will be on Thursday the 13<sup>th</sup>. Papa is at work again - but is careful and is not obliged to walk so much as he has a span of colts at hand and they are gentle & pleasant to drive. Quite a pretty span, he & Muck are fond of them. I wish you were to be here longer to enjoy driving them. Prof Carey & family are here, boarding

at Mrs. Dwores. They are  
delighted with the place.  
Mr. Dany is quite happy to  
do the rowing when they go  
out with our girls. Mrs. Cusk-  
ing invited them up there  
& we expect to direct them  
to Chatham tomorrow.  
Grandpa has gone back, but  
is coming again before long.  
Mavis is still in town and  
Grandpa wants her to make  
him a visit. Mel & Philip  
went up to Pt. Fortune last  
week arriving there Dominion  
day. They took tea with us  
Sunday and Mel spoke as  
if he had enjoyed his visit  
with you very much. I suppose  
Auntie Sarah & Laura will  
be home the last of this  
week - we miss that child

more than 2 or 3 big children.  
The reason Papa has not sent  
the money at once is because  
he has been waiting for a  
barge to take some wood down  
& would go to Montreal himself.  
If it does not come soon he will  
send to Grandpa, who said he  
would attend to it. Mr. Dany  
thinks this going to Prince Edward  
a splendid chance for you - so do  
we & understand how people  
can be sad & glad at the same
