In a late letter D^r Dawson kindly mentioned that he had asked you to send me a copy of each years Report also any of the previous ^{years} ones you had by you: for altho I had many times tried to procure these reports I never have been able. My reason for writing you now is, that as the demand for these reports

is incessant. if I fail in
procuring one return I may
lose the opportunity.

not trespassing on yr^s
kindness to oblige me.

Lately I have found some
very good Lydian Houe in
place, and was able (tho' only
with my small picks) to get
some good sized pieces - I have
a couple of other things which
I cannot recognize yet.
Last week I got a twin

pyrochlore - a beauty.

Dr. Stadelmüller sent me some
very nice things in exchange
for the box I forwarded him
he considered that white crystalline
coating or masses of small
white or semi-transparent crystals
on pyrochlore is albite. - have
you tried it? I should
also like to know what you
thought of that lime which
I fused the precipitate with Pot.^{ash} Ferro.

anything we have here like the

Hydres look like the Gabbro.
