I think it worthwhile
to expend a sheet of note paper
in telling you that most of
the Indians with whom we shall
come in contact set considerable
value on Vermillion which they
use in painting themselves.

The Vermillion used for this purpose
that I have seen - is made up
like sudlitz powders, 10 in one
packet at \$2.50 U.S. currency per

packet. It bears the superscription
"Pougeburgh" — but whether this
is the name of a town in the States
or of the manufacturer I cannot
say.

The Red River is flooded
over bank, it is said, and I
shall probably be delayed for
a few days at Moorhead
within 24 hours of which
place I now am.
