rather early, you can get  
to town early enough in the

which boat passes Salen;  
on the Mull or left side  
of the Sound of Mull -  
I live at Knock -

3½ miles from Salem,  
where there is an inn.

I hope you may  
be able to come on  
Tuesday next, the 24<sup>th</sup>. -  
leaving London on Monday  
Evng - having tickets for Oban -

Woolwich Hall and I  
are both at the Station  
Wed, Oban on Monday  
Evng the 23<sup>d</sup> & so on to

Lalen and Knock as  
Monday morning early. The  
boat passes Falls about  
2 hours from Oban to Lalen.

As there are 2 Palens  
the Mull Lalen is often  
called aros from an old castle  
close by, but there is another  
Pier at Aros at which you  
do not land. Lalen Pier,  
near Aros is San Pier.
