We are sending these to Mr Fenley Hunter of New York who, this summer, made a three months trip into the Frances Lake country as a result of having become interested in it through reading The Geological Survey reports of your brother's expedition of 1887.

You may be interested in hearing that Mr Hunter told us that many of the old Indians remember your brother very well, speaking to Mr Hunter of him as the great Geologist. Mr Hunter ~~also~~ also told us that in spite of the fact, that he had two good men and a motor in his canoe, he was unable to equal the travelled time made by your brother.

n You will also be interested to know that Mr Hunter has made a contract with the Hudson's Bay Company to renew, with concrete, the post set in The Liard Canyon B.C. Boundary by your brother in 1887.
