but we have as yet

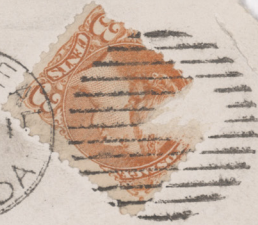
had no sun & rain
