



THE CHARGES

THE CHANCELLOR'S CHARGE:

"I, Ray Edwin Powell, Chancellor of McGill University, in the name of the Board of Governors of the University and by the authority of its Statutes, do invest you, Harold Rocke Robertson, with the Office and Title of Principal and Vice-Chancellor, in order that you may hold this Title in peace and in honour and integrity, and may administer this Office in accordance with the Statutes, privileges, liberties and customs of this University."

THE VISITOR'S CHARGE:

"I, Georges P. Vanier, Governor-General of Canada and, by Letters Patent given by our Gracious Queen Victoria in the sixteenth year of Her reign, Visitor of this University, do receive Harold Rocke Robertson to the Office of Principal and Vice-Chancellor of the University; and, in testimony thereof, I entrust the Charter and Seal of the University to his keeping."
